SOME PLASTICS AREN'T RECYCLABLE

The following plastic items are not currently recyclable: film plastic, plastic bags, shrink wrap, bubble wrap, plastic clamshells/takeout containers, plastic utensils, plastic cup lids & straws, foam/styrofoam, & plastic delivery mailers. Place these





items in your **gray garbage** container.

A WORD ABOUT CARDBOARD

Unlike the items mentioned above, cardboard can currently be recycled. All clean, dry cardboard should be placed in the **blue recycling** container (**yellow lid** side/container, if applicable). To create more room in the recycling container and help prevent litter, flatten all cardboard and paper boxes and cut larger pieces to 3' x 3'
